Weather Report Projects Germany



Without beating around the bush, it is clear that the turbulent global climate is also having an impact on business. Whether it is the conflict in Ukraine, the conflict in the Middle East or the EU-US tariff dispute, all of these issues have a direct impact on our business.

Political change in Germany and the upcoming elections in the US have not made business any easier in our two largest markets, Germany and the US. Unfortunately, the US share of production in Honhardt has slumped significantly.





We also enjoyed some sunny moments during the construction of a particularly beautiful Ø23m lunging hall with a sliding ring horse walker in the south of Munich.

At the beautiful facility of a Turkish entrepreneur family in Dreieich near Frankfurt, a colleague's old horse walker was unable to withstand the daily storms, so we were asked to install new technology in the building.



We built oval sliding rail horse walkers for the Lehrfeld family in Brandenburg, the Reich family in the Allgäu region, and the Betz family in the Swabian Alb, among others.

The Volkmann family from the Montabaur area are horse lovers through and through. Among other things, they have a particular fondness for horses of Spanish origin. This year, following deliveries to the family stable in Sainerholz and the branch in Andalusia, we were able to install a third horse walker for the Volkmann family. The different weather conditions at the various locations are therefore no challenge!

In Fürth near Nuremberg, we were commissioned to completely renovate the horse walker at Horsepark Sprehe, including the fencing and rubber flooring. This has upgraded the facility and will now enable it to continue supporting the work of successful show jumper Jörne Sprehe for many years to come. Jörne continued her career with her Hanoverian horse, Toys, winning this year's Nations Cup in Mannheim, among other achievements. We wish her continued success!

At the Aquamotion rehabilitation centre in Glandorf, Germany's largest water horse walker, measuring 10x20 meters, was put into operation in the summer of 2025. As a complete supplier of concrete construction and filtration, we worked with the customer to develop a unique concept.





The delivery of a fantastic 20x20m sliding rail horse walker to a well-known family in the vacuum cleaner business, a lunging hall with a sliding ring horse walker and partial roof, and many other projects rounds off our business in Germany.

Total realisation Stud farm El Sur, Neustadt an der Orla



This year, Jochen Stargardt's El Sur stud farm celebrated its second anniversary.

As the general contractor for the construction of this beautiful facility, we built

a lunging hall with a Ø 23m ceiling-mounted horse walker,
a round stable with a Ø18m diameter and 11 stalls,
a corner stable with 20 stalls and a
storage hall measuring 15x25m,

ensuring that the thoroughbred horses can be housed and cared for in the best possible way.

The stud farm, with its first-class management, is attracting more and more attention and recognition nationwide.

Weather Report Projects Europe & the rest of the world

We are particularly pleased that the successful Irish Olympic show jumper Cian O'Conner has built a high-quality, fully covered horsewalker at his Karlswood Stables.



A very attractive horsewalker was built for a successful rider in eastern Poland. We were able to supply five more horsewalker to the Hong Kong Jockey Club.

In addition, horsewalker in Austria, Switzerland, and Portugal, the first KRAFT horse walker to the Cape of Good Hope in South Africa and orders to Doha, Qatar rounded off our global activities.



Weather Report Projects USA



The first half of the year in the USA was characterised by caution and uncertainty due to the tariff dispute, the upcoming elections, and the strong euro, which made products from Honhardt significantly more expensive in the USA.

As we also manufacture in the USA, we were able to offset this development at the expense of our home location. In the USA, we carried out projects across the country and in every equestrian discipline. Show jumping on the one hand and racehorse breeding in Kentucky on the other clearly continued to play a major role.

A particularly great project in Texas was the oval slide rail horse walker for the XCS Ranch, owned by a well-known Formula 1 family that is extremely successful in western riding.

Oli was victorious several times this year with Ludo in M-level dressage. She made her debut in the S-class, but unfortunately only briefly, as Ludo then had to take a long break due to injury. Black Beauty by Kingston was successful at competitions with Natalie and was sold to a young rider in the area.

With 5-year-old Bärbel von Bourbon and 3-year-old Flowi Powi, we have two more youngsters on offer and working with them is great fun.
